Background

- Post Construction Completion (PCC) portion of the pipeline has gained increased attention in the last 6 years.
- 62% of NPL sites were construction complete at the end of FY2005.

This area needs more focus, attention, and resources.

Some Components of PCC

- Long-Term Response Action (LTRA)
- Operation and Maintenance (O&M)
- Five-Year Reviews
- Institutional Controls (ICs)
- Remedy Optimization
- NPL Deletion
- Site Reuse

PCC Strategy Focus

 Superfund Office Director requested development of strategy. Issued 10/12/05.

 Concentration is on current and former NPL sites, plus Superfund Alternative sites.

 It's a national strategy to manage PCC, not how to manage an individual site.

Strategy outlines approach for the next five years.

Goals

Goal 1: Ensure that remedies remain protective and cost effective.

Goal 2: Ensure that institutional controls required as part of the remedy are implemented and effective.

Goals (cont.)

Goal 3: Assure adequate financing and capability to conduct post construction.

Goal 4: Support appropriate reuse of sites while assuring remedy reliability.

Goal 5: Improve site records management to better ensure remedy reliability

Implementation

 Most projects are staffed, and implementation is initiated.

 Biggest issue is probably refocusing staff on this portion of the pipeline.

 Expectation is to update the strategy after five years.
